S.N	Tools	Descriptions
1	<p style="text-align: center;">Marquee Tool</p> 	<p>There are four types of Marquee Tool ...</p> <p>(i) Rectangular Marquee Tool: From this you can draw a rectangular line, for this you can press the Shift button in the keyboard and drag it according to your mouse.</p> <p>(ii) Elliptical Marquee Tool- From this you can draw an oval-like shape, for this you can press the Shift button on the keyboard and Drag through the mouse.</p> <p>(iii) Single Row marquee Tool- It selects a single line from the right and left of any image or particular area or draws a thin line. If you want, you can thicken this thin line by going to the Stroke option ...</p> <p>(iv) Single Column Marquee Tool- This is a tool inside Photoshop that selects a single line or a thin line above or below any image or Particular area.</p>
2	<p style="text-align: center;">Lasso Tool</p> 	<p>✎ With the help of Lasso tool, you can create a freeform outline around an object, that is, you can select any image or any particular area you want to select through it.</p>
3	<p style="text-align: center;">Polygonal Lasso Tool</p> 	<p>✎ This is also a tool to select, but it selects the edges of any image or particular area in a polygonal way, that too after clicking, that is, if you want to select an image or other things then first of all. you have to click from where you want to start the selection, after that you have to click on it as far as you want to select, similarly you have to do it in turn until That your entire area is not selected as you wanted to do ...</p>

4	<p>Magnetic Lasso Tool</p> 	<p>✎ It is also a selection tool but it is completely different from Lasso and Polygonal tool. When you select the Magnetic lasso tool inside Photoshop and select any image, it automatically selects the same color all around, only you have to move the mouse.</p>
5	<p>Crop Tool</p> 	<p>✎ With the help of this tool, you can cut any Particular Area or Image, but yes, for this you can select the Height and Width immediately after selecting this tool, this option in the Properties Bar above able to see...</p>
6	<p>Magic Wand Tool</p> 	<p>✎ It is known by its name that this tool is going to do some magic. Yes, if you select any object with this tool, then this tool will select the same colors at once, which is quite a magical work that means if the background of your image is of the same color then this tool's With the help of this you can delete the background at once because it selects the same color.</p>
7	<p>Slice Tool</p> 	<p>✎ Use of this tool is used to cut an image into many parts. You can use it for Web Page because when you cut any image with the help of this tool, you can save the web page option while saving it. Have to choose</p>
8	<p>Slice Select Tool</p> 	<p>✎ Through this, you can move, select or enlarge the image sliced by the Slice tool.</p>
