








28	<p style="text-align: center;">Path Selection Tool</p> 	<p>✎ Understand by example: Suppose you have drawn many Shape inside Photoshop and you want to select one Shape out of all those Shapes, that is, to select or move a Shape from one place to another, then you can use this black selection tool i.e. Path Selection Tool...</p>
29	<p style="text-align: center;">Direct Selection Tool</p> 	<p>✎ Understand by example: Suppose you have drawn a Shape inside Photoshop and you want to make that Shape bigger, smaller or any of its edges smaller or bigger, then you can use this tool i.e. Direct Selection Tool Which is of bright color...</p>
30	<p style="text-align: center;">Horizontal Type Tool</p> 	<p>✎ This tool is used to write Horizontally a text. When you select this tool, you have to drag the mouse as far as you want to write something, after that you can write any text Horizontally.</p>
31	<p style="text-align: center;">Vertical Type Tool</p> 	<p>✎ It is also a tool to write text, but it writes any Text vertically.</p>
32	<p style="text-align: center;">Horizontal Type Mask Tool</p> 	<p>✎ Understand by example: - It happens that wherever you write something in this document using this tool, it will capture the outline of the entire area, after that when you drag it to another page or elsewhere. If you go, that image will also be seen inside that text.</p> <p>You must have often seen that inside the text there is a photo of someone, that is, the text with the image.</p>

33	<p style="text-align: center;">Vertical Type Mask Tool</p> 	<p>✎ It also has the same function as the Horizontal Type Mask Tool, but it works vertically ...</p>
34	<p style="text-align: center;">Pen Tool</p> 	<p>✎ This is a selection tool through which you can draw or select any Shape according to your wish, but keep in mind that it is not freeform selection.....</p>
35	<p style="text-align: center;">FreeForm Pen Tool</p> 	<p>✎ It also works like the Pen Tool, but it is Freeform Selection, through which you can draw or Selection any shape you wants.</p>
36	<p style="text-align: center;">Add Anchor Point Tool</p> 	<p>✎ You can use it to add any Shape points. If you want this line to be slightly larger, you can use the Add Anchor Point Tool for this</p> <p>Note: - It is being known from its name that adding any additional Anchor / Point to any point.....</p>
37	<p style="text-align: center;">Delete Anchor Point Tool</p> 	<p>✎ Through this you can delete the added Anchor.</p>


38	<p style="text-align: center;">Convert Point Tool</p> 	<p>✎ On a path, you can use it to convert a corner point Click on a corner point and convert it into a smooth point.</p>
39	<p style="text-align: center;">Shape Tool</p> 	<p>✎ There are many Shape given in this tool, you can use the Shape you want to use.</p>
40	<p style="text-align: center;">Notes Tool</p> 	<p>✎ With the help of this tool, you can create a separate note inside any Photoshop document.</p>
41	<p style="text-align: center;">Audio Annotation Tool</p> 	<p>✎ With the help of this tool, you can record audio in any document in Photoshop and attach it and listen to it as output.</p>
42	<p style="text-align: center;">Eyedropper Tool</p> 	<p>✎ With the help of this tool, you can steal the color of one place and use it in another place, that is, you can pick the color of another place and use it wherever you want.</p>
43	<p style="text-align: center;">Color Sampler Tool</p> 	<p>✎ This tool shows the value of the color shown on the display, how much value is there for which color, for this you open any one image in Photoshop, then select this tool and click on any part of that image. Finally you will see its information in the Color Panel.</p>

44	<p style="text-align: center;">Measure Tool</p> 	<p>✎ The work is being known by the name of this tool. Yes, through this you can measure the distance from one point to another point.</p>
45	<p style="text-align: center;">Hand Tool</p> 	<p>✎ By using this tool, when we do not see the image of the entire page created by us, after selecting this tool, we move it through the mouse. Move the tool on the side you want to see the image through the mouse</p>
46	<p style="text-align: center;">Zoom Tool</p> 	<p>✎ With this you can zoom in the page. Note: - If you want to zoom in the page, then by selecting the zoom tool, you can zoom as much as you want by pressing the left button of the mouse, but to zoom out, you have to click the left button of the mouse with Alt in the keyboard. ...</p>
47	<p style="text-align: center;">Set Foreground & Background Color</p> 	<p>✎ There is no need to tell me about it, it is always used, it is used to change the background or foreground color of a page and can use it in the color fill etc.</p>
