





Photoshop Part-8, Filter Menu

Photoshop Part-9, Filter Menu



Note:- In this menu, there are many options that can be used to show/preview and hide any options that appear on the page maker home screen. such as.....

(1) **Proof Setup:** This is the setup of the entire image color, which on using the color of the image is proof/change according to the picture. This is a very easy option; you can check all the options in turn.



(2) **Proof Colors:** It is used to remove proof color again after it is used. You can delete this option if you want to delete the mean proof color option after it is used.

(3) **Gamut Colors:** It also changes the color of the image, but Gamut Color is...

(4) **Zoom In:** This allows you to zoom the page or picture.


(5) **Zoom Out:** This allows you to zoom out the page or picture.

(6) **Fit On Screen:** This fits according to the image screen.

(7) **Actual Pixel:** It is used to see pixels of any image. When you click on this option, your image will zoom in too much so that you can see the pixel of your image.


(8) **Print Size:** You can use it to see the print size.

(9) **Show:** It is used to show or remove options such as Grid, Target Path, Selection Edges.



(10) **Ruler:** It is used to show or remove the ruler in photoshop.

(11) **Snap To:** There are many options you can bring or delete.



(12) **Lock Guides:** It is used to lock the guide

(13) **Clear Guides:** It is used to remove the taken Guide


(14) **New Guide:** This allows you to take a new Guide.

(15) **Lock Slice:** It is used to lock any slices applied.

(16) **Clear Slice:** Use it to clear any slice applied.




Photoshop Part-10, Windows Menu
